Receive public input on scope and content of Environmental Impact Report (EIR)


- All comments must be received in writing to be included in the Draft EIR

Project Purpose


Replenish the San Fernando Groundwater Basin with purified recycled water to:

Groundwater Replenishment






Project Overview Map


Alternative Conveyance Valley Generating Station


Environmental Review Process
