Western District Yard Renovation

Project Description

The Western District Yard (WDY) is an important Water System facility located on an 8.4-acre property in West Los

renovated in phases in order to keep the facility open and operating during construction. Project improvements will include a new administration building, a warehouse, a weld shop, an outdoor material storage area, a fleet building and a tool room. There will also be new landscaping, a new parking structure, and new perimeter walls. Among the goals for the WDY project is Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver level, with a path created to achieve LEED Gold and eventually LEED Platinum, as well as Net Zero Energy status.
