Paradise Camp Dump Site Remediation Project

An Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) has been prepared by the City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) for the proposed Paradise Camp Dump Site Remediation Project. LADWP is the Lead Agency, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), responsible for preparation of this document.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

LADWP proposes to implement a remediation project for the former Paradise Camp Dump Site located in Mono County, California. The goals of the remediation project are to stabilize existing wastes, reduce existing and future exposure risks, and minimize the potential for future illegal waste disposal at the site. Remediation would include removing California hazardous waste at the western portion of the site, separating and recycling surface and near surface wastes, consolidating remaining non-hazardous and non-recyclable wastes, and installing waste covers. Once remediation is complete and the site is regraded, vegetation will be restored via broadcasting and imprinting a combination of annual and perennial native plant species.

PROJECT LOCATION

Paradise Camp Dump Site is located near the Paradise Transfer Station, south of the community of Paradise, in Mono County, California. Access to the site is via Lower Rock Creek Road. The site is located just west of Highway 395, approximately 13 miles northwest of Bishop, California. Lower Rock Creek runs west of, and immediately adjacent to, the project site. The closest residences to the dump site are approximately 0.6 mile to the south and 1 mile to the northwest in the community of Paradise.

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PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
